RCRA is environmental legislation aimed at controlling the generation, treating, storage, transportation and disposal of hazardous wastes. It is administered by the EPA - Title 40 CFR.

All generators of hazardous waste must meet certain requirements under the Resource Conservation and Recovery Act (RCRA). This program is designed to meet both your State and Federal RCRA requirements. If you are a large quantity generator, you have additional responsibilities relative to your company's contingency plan.

Who Should Attend? Everyone at your facility responsible for hazardous waste management and/or disposal; Company Emergency Coordinators for both small and large quantity generators.
